

What is T1L1?

- *Teach One to Lead One*® (T1L1) is a **14 week** community-based mentoring program that partners with schools in their pre-existing character initiatives.
- A team of adult mentors volunteer once a week to come into a class to lead the program. (We generally have a 4:1 student:adult ratio). Our program is designed for 90 minutes, but is adjustable to be specific to each school (usually a class period of about 50 minutes). T1L1 works alongside transitional classes, guided skills classes, support classes, or any class that is designed for the students who are at-risk or may be failing. We also have partnered with schools where certain students are pulled out of class to attend T1L1.
- T1L1 teaches universal ethical principles in the context of positive relationships to help build healthy habits and character. These principles that are true for anyone, anywhere, at anytime are the following: Respect, Integrity, Self-Control, Courage, Excellence, Compassion, Humility, Teamwork, Enthusiasm, and Honor.
- The T1L1 program is FUN! We play games, show video clips, lead student role plays, and engage in large group and small group discussions. Each student also has a field guide journal to write in as they work through the program.
- T1L1 students participate in a **community service project** as they "try on" these principles. At the end of the program, we have a **graduation** ceremony where the students are celebrated and given a **certificate** showing that they have completed a character development and leadership program.
- We track the progress of the students by giving anonymous **pre/post-assessments** at the beginning and end of the program.
- The all-in cost to mentor one student is \$125.
